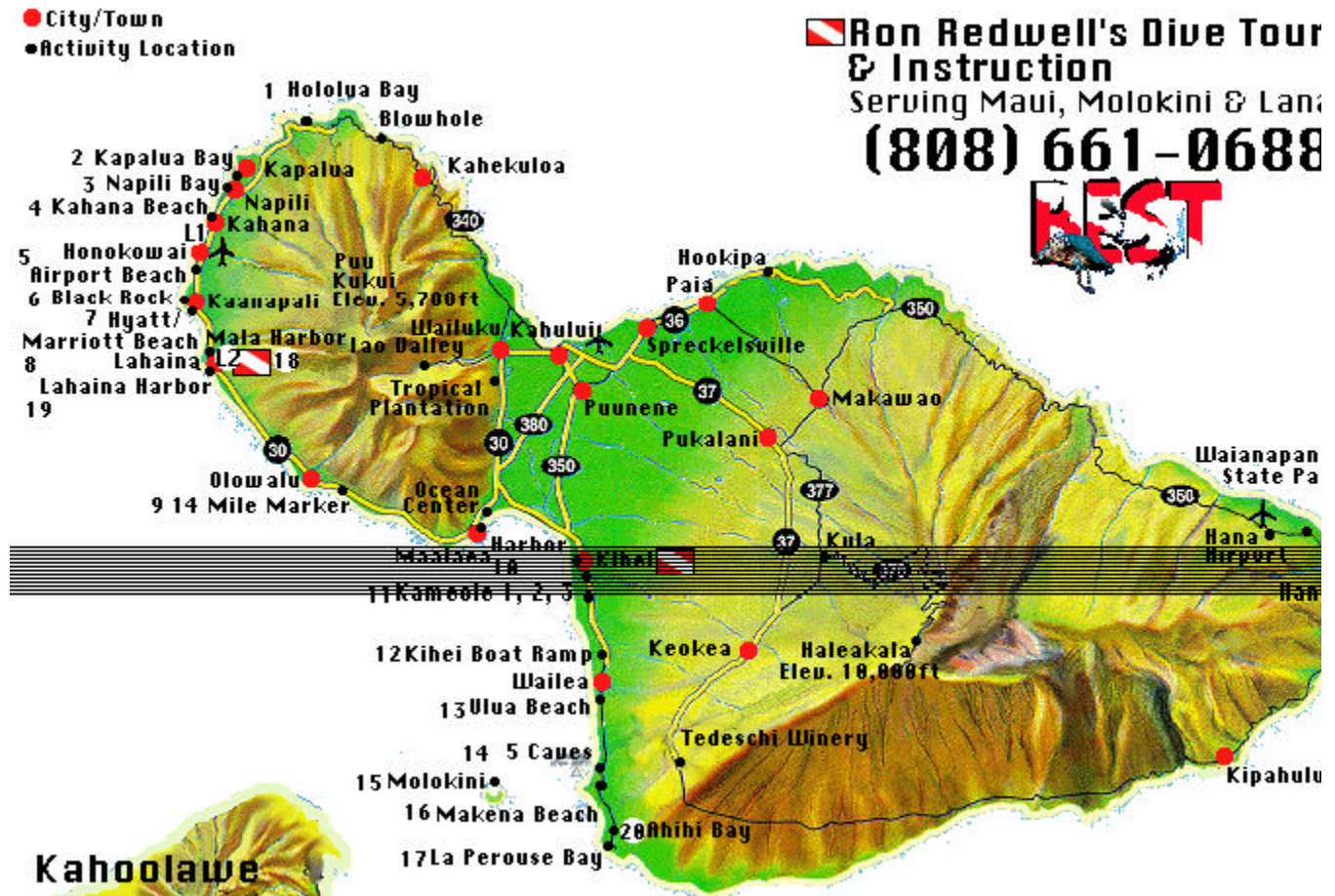

This Maui Road map & Activity Guide has detailed instructions to Maui's best dive and snorkel locations, & locations of some of Maui's key activities. You may print this map for future use. If you are having problems with the image press here for a black & white image, but you must print the guide from here.

1. Honolua Bay is a preserve North of Kapalua. It is down the dirt road with the "No Trespassing" sign. It is open to the public. Snorkel or dive the left or right side. There are more turtles on the right, but better formations on the left.
2. Kapalua bay 's beach access parking is near the restaurant. There are showers and bathrooms here. The best is at either point.
3. Napili Bay's beach access parking is in the residential area of Napili. It also has restrooms and showers. Dive the edges of the bay.
4. Kahana is nice for snorkeling and swimming.
5. Airport beach, also known as Kahikili Beach, is the last stoplight heading north into Kaanapali at the

25 mile marker. It is a public park with full facilities. It is good for beginners and families.

6. Black Rock is at the Sheraton Hotel, the first turn into Kaanapali to the dead end on the right. The Hyatt / Marriott Hotel is the dead end to the left and is also good.

7. As you enter the Hyatt you will see what looks like a service road just to the left of the entrance. This is the beach access parking. Park and walk around the building. Enter off the beach in front of the Activity booth. The reef is to the right.

8. Marriott's parking is just before the hotel. Walk to the beach and enter in front of the activity booth. The reef is to the left, very large turtles here. This is an intermediate/advanced site because of currents and surf.

9. Olowalu is the beach at the 14 mile marker south of Lahaina. It is a great beach for beginners and families. It is very shallow with little or no surf. No facilities.

10. Maalaea Harbor is where you meet the boats for trips to Molokini and fishing charters. It is also home to the new Marine Exhibit. It is great for kids, and the adults will have a great time. Eat before you go, the food is very expensive.

11.. Kamole 1,2,3 are nice beach parks in Kihei-Wailea. They all have full facilities.

12. The Kihei boat ramp is just south of Kamole 3. This is where the small dive boats leave from heading to Molokini.

13. Ulua Beach access is at the Renaissance Hotel. This is a great family/beginner beach with full facilities.

14. 5 Caves is accessed by entering Makena landing and swimming around the point or climbing down by the 5 grave markers. This is one of the best sites in South Maui. we really recommend a guide here.

15. Molokini is only accessible by boat. Beginner divers / Snorkelers leave from Lahaina Harbor or Maalaea Harbor. \*Serious divers leave from Kihei boat ramp. The Back Wall and ends are for advanced divers. Molokini is a preserve above and below the surface, please do not disturb anything in this area.

16. Makena is an easy entry area with corals along the wall. More advanced divers will want to continue out to 5 caves.

17. La Perouse is hard to find. It is a turn out in the lava fields. When you get to the end of the dirt road angle to the left. This is a good site in the winter, but can be very rough with the summer swells.

18. Mala Harbor is where you leave for dive trips to Lanai. The collapsing pier to the left is also a great dive site for advanced or guided dives. Look carefully for old bottles, plates, etc.

19. Lahaina Harbor is behind the Banyon Tree and King III school. Many of Maui's charters leave from here.

20. Ahihi Bay is a preserve in the residential area south of Makena beach. Park along the road and enter by the slab. Snorkeling and diving is to the left. Remember, it is a preserve so please be kind.
